Evening Worship: 2 John is a short letter from John the Apostle to one of the churches he oversees in his role as a "regional" elder. The first half of the letter, which we looked at previously, stressed the call for Christians to walk in obedience to the truth, especially God's command to love on another. The second half of the letter of the letter is a warning against those who do not acknowledge the humanity of Jesus. Such a teaching strips the Gospel of its power and must be firmly resisted.
