Welcome to Worship at Immanuel

Pastor Kevin Muyskens May 15, 2022

Morning Worship: This morning Pastor Kevin will continue our series in Jude. Relying on the authority of dreams instead of scripture or the apostles, the bad apples who snuck into the community of believers led people into immorality, rejecting authority, and slander. Jude calls these people "hidden reefs"; they are a great danger lurking unseen. Our response to such poor example is to watch out for them, avoid them, and dig them out.

Communion: This morning the sacrament of the Lord's Supper will be served. A sacrament is a means by which God gives us his grace which we receive by faith. We ask that those participating have faith in Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord and that they have affirmed that faith by a public statement such as profession of faith, confirmation, or adult baptism. Additionally, the Lord's Supper is a statement of our communion with one another, so if one is holding something against a fellow believer and has not sought reconciliation, that person should consider refraining from the supper.

Evening Worship: Elisha is the successor of the great prophet Elijah. Elijah's departure from the earth is unique as he does not die but is taken up to heaven in a whirlwind accompanies by a chariot of fire. The fact that Elisha was allowed to observe this confirmed that he was receiving the oldest son's double portion of Elijah's spirit. Immediately this blessing is confirmed by the "company of the prophets" that the spirit of Elijah was resting on Elisha. In the ministry of Elisha we see the Lord caring for the remnant of his people through the leadership he provides and empowers.
