Welcome to Worship at Immanuel

Morning Worship: This morning we will return to the worship gathering among the Christians in Corinth. 1 Corinthians provides a great deal of insight into their worship because the Apostle Paul is correcting problems that had arisen. The problem in today's scripture is worship had become about individual displays and actions that did not include or build up the rest of the worshipers. This serves as a reminder that we worship together as a body, not a collection of individuals, and that our worship is to be both glorifying to God and enriching to those in attendance.

Evening Worship: This evening Pastor Kevin will continue leading us through the beginning of Romans. Romans 1:8-17 speak of Paul's longing to visit Rome to share the gospel, "because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes." Some of the interest of this passage is that it presents Paul's emotions of hope, longing, disappointment, and confidence, all of which are seen in the light of the gospel of Jesus. This passage will help us see our own actions and emotions in the light of that most important truth.

This morning we celebrate the sacrament of the Lord's Supper. A sacrament is a Godgiven action that displays the truth of Jesus' mission for us in a physical, acted out manner. In the Lord's Supper we proclaim Jesus' death as our only way to receive eternal life, so we ask that all who participate have publicly proclaimed their faith in Jesus as Savior and Lord through a profession of faith, confirmation, or believer's baptism. The supper is also a God-given means of grace by which God passes on to us the blessings of Jesus Christ. All communion elements are gluten-free.
