As we wonder at the description of weight of the gold nails, we are reminded that the temple was built according to the instructions of God. Our obedience is also to God-given instructions, and we do not understand the purpose of all of these instructions but are called to trust God and therefore to follow His instructions.

Evening Worship: This evening, we conclude our journey through the sermon to the Hebrews. In the final chapter the writer shifts his tone from that of a sermon to that of a letter. He is making applications, asking for prayers, and finally closes with a great blessing: “Now may the God of peace ... equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever.” Let us stretch out our hands to receive that great blessing along with the Jewish Christian recipients of this letter.
