**Evening Worship:** One of the favorite stories of the Elijah/Elisha cycle is the account of the capture of the Aramean army. When an entire army surrounds the village home of the prophet Elisha, his servant is terrified. In a stunning reversal the prophet shows that God is powerful and active in Israel protecting his people. Indeed, the LORD is powerful enough that his people can afford to show mercy even to their enemies. This sounds suspiciously close to Jesus' words that call on us to love our enemies and pray for our persecutors.
