In a stunning reversal the prophet shows that God is powerful and active in Israel protecting his people. Indeed, the LORD is powerful enough that his people can afford to show mercy even to their enemies. This sounds suspiciously close to Jesus' words that call on us to love our enemies and pray for our persecutors.
