While admonishing does include correcting or encouraging a change, the Bible presents the practice of admonition as an extension of that love and care that can be done well in the context of trusting relationships.

Evening Worship: Tonight we'll reach the conclusion of Ezekiel's vision that has taken up chapters 8-11. The chapter presents the desolation of the glory of the LORD finally leaving the temple, but on its way it makes a last stop above "the mountain east of (the city)." This is the Mount of Olives which was prevalent in Jesus' ministry and was the place of his ascension to heaven. We'll see some incredible ties to Jesus' first and second coming as Ezekiel's vision points to the hope we find in Christ alone.
